In two weeks, the weekend of November 2nd and 3rd, Fr. Lawrence Villone, Missionary of the Blessed Sacrament priest, will be here at all the Masses at St. Thomas Aquinas to present and promote Perpetual Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. As many of you know, we have a beautiful chapel ready to go thanks to various donors from the parish community and beyond. We are particularly grateful for these individuals and companies. I would encourage you to attend his presentation during the time of the homily on Eucharistic Adoration at one of the Masses at St. Thomas Aguinas.
