PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

This coming week, we have the Feast of All Saints, Friday November 1st. It is a holy day of obligation. Catholics are obliged to attend Mass either on the Vigil or on the Feast Day. I would strongly encourage you to make this your utmost priority! I found a story that I thought gives us some background on the Universal Call to Holiness and Sainthood.

A pumpkin story: "What is it like to be a Christian saint?"
"It is like being a Halloween pumpkin. God picks you from the field, brings you in, and washes all the dirt off you by inviting you to confess your sins and seek reconciliation. Then he cuts off the top and scoops out the yucky stuff. He removes the pulp of impurity and injustice and seeds of doubt, hate, and greed from you. Then He carves you a new smiling face and puts His light of holiness or Holy Spirit inside you to shine for the entire world to see by your serving and sharing love, mercy and forgiveness." This is the Christian idea behind the carved pumpkins during the Halloween season. (Fr. Tony Kadavil). The next day, November 2, is All Souls Day. On All Souls Day, we remember those gone before us marked with the sign of faith. Both parishes, we will be calling off individuals names who have died this past year. We want to remember them in a special way. If you have a loved one who died since November 2018 to the present time and would like a candle lit, please call the office and attend this important Mass on Sunday November 3rd either at Immaculate Conception, St. Marys or St. Thomas Aquinas. There is a history in the Jewish tradition for the remembrance of the dead. The Talmud states that the prayers for the dead will help to bring greater rewards and blessings to the deceased. Orthodox Jews also recite prayers 11 months after the death of a loved one so he or she will be purified. It is called the Mourner's Kaddish. Jesus and his apostles also shared this belief and passed it on to the early church. "Remember us who have gone before you, in your prayers" is a popular inscription found on the walls of the Roman catacombs. There is biblical evidence from the Old Testament and New Testament Scriptures. From the Old Testament or Hebrew Scriptures-we find the Jewish belief in the need of prayer and sacrifice for the dead in 2 Maccabees 12:46. Proverbs 24:16-tells us that the just sin seven times a day. St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians speaks about saved but as going through fire-(1 Corinthians 3:11-15), In Revelations 21:27-we are told, 'nothing unclean shall enter heaven.' Early Church Fathers, Tertullian (160-240 A.D.), Augustine (354-430 A.D.) advised widows to pray for their husbands and St. Monica, St. Augustine's mother requested: "When I die, bury me anywhere you like, but remember to pray for me at the altar." (Fr. Tony Kadavil and Confessions Book 9, Chapter 11, Section 27). The church synods of Nicea, Florence, and Trent all encouraged the offerings of prayers to the dead. The Catechism of the Catholic Church promulgated by St. John Paul II states, 'almsgiving, indulgences, and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead.

Last, but not least, I would like you all to invite to attend the Mission for Perpetual Adoration on Saturday/Sunday November 2nd and 3rd. Fr. Lawrence Villone, Missionary of the Blessed Sacrament, will be here next weekend to talk to us about the graces and need for spending time with the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. My hope is that you will be here for this inspiring talk!


