Dear Parishioners:

It warmed my heart to see so many of you last week in your cars driving through to get your palms and sacramentals.

I want to thank you for your generosity with your tithe contributions and building fund. It was truly humbling to see the witness and great spiritual and financial sacrifices many of you were making to help keep St. Thomas Aquinas and Immaculate Conception, St. Marys continuing to operate. We brought in \$71 in plate and \$3581 for tithes from Immaculate Conception and \$5278.82 in tithes and \$3195 for the Building Fund for St. Thomas Aquinas. Once again, thank you for your generosity. On another happy note.

Happy Easter to you all! He is alive, Alleluia! It's great to say the 'A' word again and in the Season of Easter, there is that ray of hope in the midst of the darkness of the coronavirus pandemic.
