PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Happy Easter to you all! I hope and pray that you were all able to have some time with family and friends over the Easter holidays, more like close to a White Easter this year.

It was great seeing many of you on Palm Sunday after a long hiatus of nearly month without Mass. We are going into our second month without public Eucharistic celebrations. I hear the challenges many of you are vocalizing to me at Adoration, the grocery stores, restaurants where there is take out only, or other venues that I have run into. We hear the sadness, grief, and mourning of St. Mary Magdalene as the tomb of Jesus is empty. Where have they put him? Where did they take him to? We ask the same questions, why is this happening? Why can't we receive Jesus? There is not only an empty tomb, but empty churches. This is particularly magnified on Easter, when this is a season of hope. Yet, it is a season of hope. The empty tomb gives way to the resurrection not only for Jesus, yet, for each and every one of us who believes in him. We have been given the privilege to worship in a beautiful Church over the past several years, given opportunities for gatherings for coffee and rolls in our new multi-purpose room, made space for more of religious education students, and more room for our staff to serve you with additional office space. We can use this space to give God the glory and praise, to proclaim the resurrected Lord Jesus in our midst through our prayer, hospitality, catechesis, and sacraments. We are aware that many of you are wondering if you will have jobs or work in the days, weeks, and months ahead. Given the current situation, we are trying to cut costs. Our staff is cut back to half time. I have decided to cut my salary to 2/3 and our supplies and expenses we have nearly eliminated in order to be fiscally responsible to you. Please look to the income/expenses for both parishes below. Please prayerfully consider continuing your tithes through filling out ACH forms available on the table near the reception desk in order to manage the costs at this time. We can also scan or email you a form. Please call the office at 961-3026, if you would like to make changes to your tithing contributions. Again, thank you for your generosity! It is most appreciated!
