PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

I will never forget being with the Gezel family the Sunday before Christmas and getting the news that their loved one, Joe may not make it, from one of the doctors and nurse practitioners. It was quite disheartening to say the least, our emotions were even more intensified, as this was three days before Christmas. The parish came together with prayers and fasting. The miracle occurred as Joe began to improve, to talk, and eventually go home last month. It was nothing short of a miracle. Thanks, and praise be to God!

We, often wonder, what must have been going on in the minds of Cleopas and a few others on the road to Emmaus. They were downright depressed, dejected, saddened, and grief stricken by the murder of their best friend, Jesus. Then, they speak about hearing reports of his resurrection, that He was alive! This just doesn't happen. It was all too good to be true. Then, the stranger comes along to listen, to engage in dialogue and debate, explaining the Hebrew Scriptures and all that would take place. They break bread, their hearts and minds were awakened to the realization of his presence. The stranger vanishes. Their hearts were burning, that it was not too good to be true. The stranger was Jesus. Jesus had risen and was alive! It was a hope-filled moment.

We need lots of hope these days. We are saddened by the loss of and the hunger for Jesus in the Eucharist, his body, blood, soul, and divinity. We feel the negative effects of social distancing without hugs or handshakes. We are saddened by postponing our weddings, funerals, or not being able to attend prom or our own graduations. Our baseball, track, and other sports or extra -curricular activities have either been livestreamed or downright cancelled indefinitely. We are devastated by all this news of this! Who or what is our Hope, our Refuge, our Stronghold, our Anchor during these times? Hopefully, it is the Risen Lord Jesus Christ. He is the one we can turn to-to talk even if it is venting (He knows everything, right? Why hide it from Him) or listening with our hearts. We have his Word, the Scriptures, yes, livestreamed Masses/Spiritual Communion (I know it's not the same), yet, he is here, suffering with us. You and I need to unite our sufferings to His on the Cross, knowing that the Cross and death does not have the final say, the resurrected life does. I invite us to hold on to the image of the Risen Lord during this most difficult time. The Gezels showed us that miracles do happen! Miracles will continue to happen! Let's pray and hope for end to this pandemic and renew our lives to Christ more deeply during this Easter Season! Yes, He has Risen! He is Risen, indeed! Alleluia! Happy Third Sunday of Easter!
