PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Thanks to all of our mothers, grandmothers, great grandmothers, and those who have taken on the role of motherhood with adopted children. We can also think of the life of St. Augustine. Without his mother's 34 years of prayers, the church would not have been blessed with a bishop, or one of the great figures who could articulate the truths of faith, and become a great saint later on after a life of wine, women, and song. I cannot tell you how many times I vent to God while walking in the square or in the church about all of these things that have suddenly come upon us. If you do not have a key (I know a lot of you do at Immaculate Conception, St. Marys), go to the fire station, a neighbor, or someone you know that does and ask to be let in. St. Thomas Aguinas is open from 7 a.m. until 9 p.m. Some of us have key fobs that can let us in during the night time hours for adoration. It is a great way to spend time with the Lord. I find it peaceful, relaxing, and quite refreshing to spend some time with Jesus-to fall in love with Him! He is the only one that can get us out of this mess!
