## PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Within the last month, I received a letter of resignation from Bart Brummer as a trustee and member of the Finance Council. I want to thank Bart Brummer for his 20 years of service as a member of the Finance Council and nearly 5 years as trustee for the parish. Bart has brought great wisdom, insight, advice, and dedicated service to our parish! He will be missed as a trustee for the parish of St.Thomas Aquinas. When you see Bart, please thank him for his service, time, and efforts for the parish. It is truly appreciated!

I have asked Tim Gauger, also a member of the Finance Council, to step in as Trustee. Tim brings a valuable business sense as accountant for Mid-America energy. I believe he will serve us well as trustee.

Last Monday, Bishop William Joensen began laying the ground-work for re-opening of Churches. Phase I will consist of beginning to celebrate week day Masses (Monday through Saturday morning or in our case, Tuesday through Friday) publicly with proper social distancing, sanitizing pews, more than likely, the call for wearing of masks, no sign of peace, no precious blood (except for the celebrant), removal of hymnals, and the discouragement of those in vulnerable, at risk categories to continue to watch Mass from home via television or livestream.

Phase II would be the beginning of celebrating Saturday evening and Sunday Masses publicly. Sunday Mass obligation will remain suspended for a time. Bishop Joensen, while acknowledging livestream Masses are not the same, also calls for charity, patience, and forbearance to keep our churches safe environments to help stop the spread of the corona virus. I would encourage us to prayerfully consider these factors as we make preparations for the Re-Opening of Churches. I will be in communication with you when Bishop Joensen gives us the greenlight to begin celebrating Masses publicly, whether it be weekday or weekend Masses. Let us continue to pray to the Blessed Mother Mary, all the nine choirs of angels and saints for the end of the pandemic which has hit most of the world. Blessings and peace!

The Sixth Sunday of Easter

In the Gospel of John this weekend we hear Jesus assure us "I will not leave you orphaned." At some point we all want or even need to hear these words. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
