PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We will begin to take steps for the parish re-opening process, whenever that may occur. In several counties across southwest lowa, weekday Masses began last Thursday May 21 (Technically, the Feast of the Ascension-40 days after Jesus rose from the dead). We are NOT one of the counties. Unless you are from these other counties, out of respect and charity for the parishioners, I encourage you to refrain from attending week day Masses. I know many of us are longing to receive Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. Yet, we need to take into consideration other's health and wellbeing and ourselves too. In preparation, I am putting out a call for new Ushers/Greeters. It would be great if we could train 18 people to be New Ushers/Greeters in the next weeks for the re-opening for St. Thomas Aquinas and 2 for Immaculate Conception between the ages of 30-50 years of age. Please call the office if you are interested. I am open to having high school students serve in this capacity as Ushers/Greeters. I am also trying to make time for First Communicants for St. Thomas Aquinas as we have 21 and offering them individually. I will get back with you on details on how we can arrange all this. If there are individuals, who would not mind, training new Ushers/Greeters with the new guidelines given from the Diocese, please call the office.

In the bulletin and on the website, there are procedures/guidelines given when we are ready to re-open. I would advise you to look these over. Much input has been given to those in charge to put this all together. I am confident that our parishioners will follow these guidelines in the spirit of charity and common good of all parishioners.

We begin the Feast of the Ascension this weekend. In some dioceses, it is still celebrated on Thursdays as it was formally known as Ascension Thursday (when I was first ordained). The bishops have moved this to the Sunday following Thursday to accommodate work schedules, etc. After several resurrection appearances and lessons that need to be taught to his followers, Jesus ascends into heaven to make way for the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, the Defense Attorney, who supports, guides, counsels us throughout our lifelong pilgrimage. Jesus, through the third person of the Blessed Trinity can be omni-present (present everywhere) to us. The Holy Spirit is a gift from God. We will talk about that next week on the Feast of the Pentecost. It is important to know that Jesus did not leave us alone as he ascends to the Father and the fact, that through our baptism, we are called to get busy to continue His work on earth, which involves prayer, fasting, and almsgiving (yes, even during the Easter Season!) Prayer is essential in our daily life. We know that Mother Teresa and her sisters began each day with prayer before they began their work day caring for the poor and sick. Prayer is our lifeline, our support, our help. Prayer involves that connection to God in the fact that we are His branches, He is the Vine. Fasting puts us in solidarity with the poor and the hungry. It also super-sizes our prayer (as Ellen Miller once taught me in public conversation).

Almsgiving is our service, our outreach, and extension of prayer to those who are in need. It is faith lived out in common practice. Scriptures point out that even the evil one believed in God, but of course, never followed through with that belief in prayer, fasting, or almsgiving. I wish you a Happy Memorial Day as you remember our loved ones, those who served our country so courageously, and Happy Feast of the Ascension! Please stay safe in your travels!
