### PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We celebrate the Feast of Pentecost this coming Saturday evening and Sunday morning. The Holy Spirit has come upon the apostles and St. Mary in the upper room and gifts of tongues were given which reversed Babel, where there was dispersion and division of people and languages. It was a time that all could understand each other from Jews to Greeks and others. What a gift that Jesus left for the Church! She would not be on her own or abandoned. The promise of the Spirit also meant that the Jaws of Death would not prevail over the church (it does not mean that it would not be in the church as we have discovered with the sex abuse scandals, the abuse of buying and selling of indulgences, the Crusades which initially were meant to stop infiltration of the church got out of hand and many were killed). Yet, through 2,000 years of history, the church has prevailed. What is it that kept it going in spite of human frailties, including the leadership? The Holy Spirit. The Feast of Pentecost calls to mind the Birthday of the Church. Some have tried to separate Christ from the Church. No, they are inseparable. Christ has founded this Church upon the Rock of Peter (Matthew 16). In the Gospel for the Mass of the Day this weekend, he gives power and authority to the apostles (modern day Bishops) to 'forgive and retain sins.' (John 20:19-23). We are also reminded of the importance of both the written word and oral word (tradition)-2 Thessalonians 2:15. The Church, in spite of its human weakness, has the Holy Spirit to guide as the Advocate, the Comforter, the Defense Attorney to help discern the spirits of good and evil. We are a part of the Sensus Fidelium (the sense of the baptized faithful) who through our gifts can offer guidance to our leaders. We might say, "What are my gifts"? My answer: What are those things that have come naturally to me? What did I ask for at Confirmation? Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord. We could also go on and list many other gifts that one has: musical, athletic, intellectual talents, the ability to farm, nurse one back to health, engineering, the gifts we need to become a priest, religious, or deacon, etc. How are we using those for building up of the kingdom of God? Of course, the Fruits of the Spirit are: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, Goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23 NAB)

We are in the process of moving toward Phase I Re-Opening of the Church. We have no set dates yet. At the same time, we want to be prepared when the greenlight is given from the Diocese of Des Moines, Iowa. With that being said, Sunday Mass obligation is dispensed. If you are among the vulnerable, at risk, or have been exposed or tested positive to COVID-19, please remain at your homes and continue to watch the Masses as they will be livestreamed. This is an act of charity. There will be a number of things in place: There is a strong encouragement to wear face masks (Pull down to receive communion and then pull back up after reception) and or face shields (If unwilling to wear a mask, we ask that you please sit yourselves in the Multi -purpose room), Social distancing of six feet or more (as pews will be roped off), sanitization and cleaning of pews after each Mass (will need volunteers for this, please call office), there will be no collection but baskets available at the entrance/exits of the Church, Trained Ushers/Greeters (which are in need of) will be happy to welcome you in and out of pews as a way to stagger crowds. Yes, Mass will look much differently than in pre-COVID-19 days, yet, we want to maintain the safety of all parishioners. I ask for your patience when the time comes for us to begin daily Masses. Blessings and peace! Happy Pentecost Sunday!
