PASTOR REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Please welcome our newest members of St. Thomas Aguinas Catholic Church. Last Saturday evening, the Pentecost Vigil, Saturday May 30, 7:00 p.m. Raynold Kanai, Jr., Thomas Parker, and Kyle Gebel were given the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. They have been preparing for this time since last Fall. Congratulations once again to Raynold Kanai, Jr., Thomas Parker, and Kyle Gebel for being the new Catholic Christians from St. Thomas Aquinas! As many of you know by now, we will begin Phase I of the Re-Opening Stage (Re-Opening daily Masses) on Thursday June 11, 8:00 a.m. Mass at St. Thomas Aguinas and 6:00 p.m. Mass at Immaculate Conception, St. May's. Again, I am asking that those who are vulnerable, at risk, having the symptoms of dry cough, fever, and difficulty breathing to refrain from attending Mass. It is out of charity that we would do this. We will look to the worship spaces, gathering area (St. Thomas Aguinas), Multi-purpose Room (St. Thomas Aguinas), and Hall (Immaculate Conception) for overflow if needed. We ask that you sanitize your hands-on arriving, sanitize your hands before receiving Holy Communion, and sanitize your hands when you leave. This will help to diminish any spread of the disease. It may seem overly cautious/burdensome/redundant to some, but please, keep in mind the safety and protection of all our fellow parishioners. I don't know any of us who would wish this virus on anyone. Thank you for your cooperation on these matters!

We will let you know when weekend Masses will begin. Hopefully, it will be in a few weeks after Phase I is implemented. Livestreaming will continue for both weekday and Saturday/Sunday Masses on Facebook. Msgr. Bognanno and I, along with the pastoral and finance councils are in conversation about having more masses on Saturdays and Sundays in order to accommodate our parishioners with the limited space and social distancing requirements.

Again, I ask for your patience during this time. Masses will NOT look like pre-Covid times for some time!
