### Dear Parishioners:

Welcome back to all of you for the beginning of Phase II Weekend Masses! It seems like an eternity since we had public Masses on a weekend. Who of us would ever have thought that a year ago, we would have had Saturday evening and Sunday Masses suspended for over three months due to a pandemic? For those who have not been to week day Masses, we have Ushers/Greeters welcoming you, escorting you to pews, escorting you to communion, and to stagger the crowds, escorting you out. It seems a little cumbersome and for some, an infringement on their religious liberties and rights, yet, we are trying to keep people safe and healthy. We highly encourage wearing masks and receiving communion on the hand, sanitizing your hands upon arrival, before receiving communion, and before leaving Church. Those who do NOT desire to wear a mask or to receive on the tongue or have some celiac issues and require low gluten hosts, we ask that you please sit in the back or in the multi-purpose room. Communion will be brought to you in the hall at St. Marys and in the Multi-Purpose Room at St. Thomas. We will have seats available in the gathering area and multi-purpose room to maintain proper social distance at St. Thomas and in the hall at St. Marys. I know that St. Thomas Aguinas and Immaculate Conception parishioners are great at working with the diocesan guidelines and following procedures for their health and safety! Thank you for your cooperation! As many of you know by now, Steph Bintner, the Office Manager for St. Thomas Aquinas over the last 16 years, last day will be this Tuesday June 30th. Steph has given her heart and soul to St. Thomas Aquinas.
