### PASTORS REPORT

#### Dear Parishioners:

This week, we celebrate the Feast of the Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We celebrate only three births as they all were born without original sin: Jesus, Mary, and John the Baptist (cleansed in the womb of original sin). It is as early as the sixth century that the church in the East celebrated her birth, while the west (Roman, Latin Rite), it was celebrated in the seventh century. There are no scriptures alluding to her birth. However, the Protoevangelium of James, an apocryphal work written in about the year 150 A.D., speaks of the infertility of Ann and Joachim until an angel appeared to Ann, telling her she would conceive and bear a child. The Gospel of the Nativity of St. Mary speaks about this in more detailed fashion. This feast is not a solemnity because of its closeness to the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (which we celebrated August 15). Of course, we know the Immaculate Conception is December 8th, so naturally, nine months later, her birth would follow. St. Augustine (a fifth century bishop of Hyppo and doctor of the church), connects Mary's birth with Jesus' saving work. He states: " She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley. Through her birth the nature inherited from our first-parent changed." Speaking of the Birth of the Blessed Mother, we begin the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults Process this Tuesday September 8, 7:00 p.m. in the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Room. I would encourage anyone who is interested in joining the Catholic Christian faith or attending these sessions. We have some excellent and enthusiastic instructors who love Scriptures and the faith with Marguerite O'Meara and Deacon Dave O'Brien. Please call the office if you are interested.

Next week, the Diocese has asked us to take up a second collection for the seminarians. As you know, we have one right now who is being formed at the University of St. Thomas with Connor Lynch. He credits the Mission trips under Ellen Miller with the Eucharistic Adoration for his call to the seminary discernment (testing of spirits) process. We are blessed to also have Fr. Ray Higgins, Fr. Ross Parker, who are from St. Thomas Aquinas and Fr. Trevor Chicoine from Immaculate Conception, St. Marys as our native sons. It was your prayers and support that brought about these vocations to the priesthood. The cost for each seminarian to be trained each year can run from \$25,000-\$50,000 a year, I might be on the low side since I was vocations director over 11 years ago. The only exception would be for Loras College as an endowment has been set up so the diocese only pays for room and board. With 19 seminarians, the cost can add up. Please prayerfully consider a gift to the seminarian fund.

Also, the Diocese of Des Moines has some online giving for the latest Derecho on August 10 which destroyed many of our farmer's crops around the diocese, the explosion in Beirut, Lebanon which killed over 200 people from ammonium nitrate, and the poverty, wars, and unrest in Africa.
