## PASTORS REPORT

## Dear Parishioners:

I remember in the early days of weightlifting that I was introduced to by a college roommate. I would hear the phrase, Use it or Lose it. In other words, I need to use the muscles given and develop them or I would grow lethargic or lazy and could easily lose the muscle tone. How significant that is for us today with the Gospel from Matthew. Jesus speaks about the first servant who has been given five talents by his master, does so, invests the five talents, and doubles his investment and returns 10 talents to his master. The second servant is given two talents and doubles the investment and returns four talents to his master. The third servant is given one talent, buries it, and returns back the one talent. He is chastised by his master for not investing his talent. What does this mean? We cannot get complacent with our gifts and talents that God has given us by putting them under a bushel basket for reasons of fear, greed, or some other reason. We are invited to put them to full use by using them. We can be lulled today into spiritual lethargy or sloth, particularly now, when the requirement of Mass attendance is dispensed. Now, I am not speaking to those with underlying health conditions, those who are sick, or have some extenuating circumstance for not attending. For those of us who can come yet, choose not to, we miss out on the graces of the sacraments. Fear can grip us all, lead us into isolation, and can affect our mental, physical, psychological, and spiritual health. That comes from the evil one, not God. How am I using the talents and gifts God has given me for the purpose of sharing my faith? Am I like the first two servants who shared them, put them out, even when rejected, or do I bury the talent, like the last servant. There are eternal consequences to our choices. This comes from Jesus himself, not Fr. Chris Fontanini. Let us make the choice to share our talents and let that investment grow for the kingdom of God.

On another subject, one way, to share our talents is by plugging into Formed.org. Our high students will be hand at all Masses next weekend to help us get into the sacramental and catechetical training, Formed.org offers. Please bring your laptops to church with you next weekend. It is a great way to get renewed and strengthened in our faith! Blessings and peace! Fr. Chris
