PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

It is hard to believe, we are at the culmination of the Lenten journey with Holy Week. We begin with Jesus riding in Jerusalem on a donkey, proclaiming a message of peace as military leaders would do when riding in on a donkey. He comes as the Prince of Peace. A ticker tape parade of sorts is given to the Son of God. Palm branches are waving as they make a path for his arrival, an arrival that would soon turn dark, as the forces of evil would soon arrest this man for blasphemy and then condemn him to die a horrible cruel and agonizing death on the cross. He would give of himself the night before through the Eucharist to his disciples, soon to be apostles, predecessors of the Bishops to continue this Eucharistic sacrifice of Himself to all who would gather. Jesus would take on sin, even though he knew no sin, and would experience the abandonment of His father-lonely, cold, hanging high in the air, naked and exposed to the elements, in hours of agony on that Good Friday-almost 1990 years ago before he breathed his last, Father, into your hands, I commend my spirit. 
