PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We have four second graders from Immaculate Conception, St. Marys who will be receiving their First Communion this next weekend on Sunday April 18th at the 8:00 a.m. Mass. This Sunday marks the eighth and final day of the Octave of Easter. It is also Divine Mercy Sunday. We are reminded of God's constant mercy and fidelity in spite of our own lack of fidelity. He gently guides us back to Him as he did with St. Thomas the Apostle, who was a johnny come lately. He would not believe Jesus had risen until he probed the nail marks. Jesus does not chastise him or berate him, but offers him the opportunity to examine the nail marks. When St. Thomas the Apostle does, he states, 'My Lord and My God.' Tradition has it that he went to India where he was martyred for the faith by being stabbed with spears. We have the opportunity this weekend to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation by four priests following the noon Mass. Why come on Divine Mercy? Those who go to Mass, pray for the Holy Father's intentions, go to confession, carry out the indulgenced work (that is, public devotions to the Divine Mercy on Mercy Sunday itself, receive a plenary indulgence granted by the church. What is a plenary indulgence, we might ask? Was that not done away with Vatican II and the abuses during the Reformation?

First of all, let us define the word, 'indulgence.' An indulgence "is a means of remission of the temporal punishment for sins which have already been forgiven but are due to the Christian in this life and/or in purgatory.." (www.carm.org/roman-catholicism/what are indulgences).

A plenary indulgence frees a person from all punishment due to sin, in medical terms, it would be like a total healing of cancer, with the reversal of all the disease's consequences. In spiritual terms, a person granted a plenary indulgence would immediately enter into God's presence after dying, with all the wounds of sin healed.

It is necessary that one be in the state of grace at least at the time the indulgenced work is completed (ie. one must be a Catholic, not in schism or excommunicated. A plenary indulgence can be gained only once per day. No, indulgences did not go out with Vatican II and following the abuses of the indulgences from the Reformation.

I hope you will consider participating in the Sacrament of Reconciliation this weekend. It is a wonderful sacrament, I know I will participate myself with another priest. Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!




What is National Child Abuse Prevention Month?


