PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We welcome Msgr. Frank Bognanno, a retired priest who is well known throughout the world in some of my travels and also the usual celebrant at the 8:00 a.m. Mass will be preaching at the Sunday Masses on Eucharistic Adoration. I think it is most appropriate that we talk about the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and consider spending some time with the Lord in prayer before His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Why? It is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ or Corpus Christi. Its origins begin in 1263 with a German priest, Fr. Peter of Prague, who struggled with his own doubts about the Real Presence of Jesus. He happened to stop in a church in Bolsena, Italy to celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Christina. As Fr. Peter was reciting the prayer of consecration (take this all of you and eat of it, take this all of you and drink of it), blood started seeping from the consecrated host. Pope Urban IV, who at the time was in Orvieto ordered an investigation with the blood stained corporal. It was determined to be a true Eucharistic miracle. The relics (host and blood stained corporal) were placed in the Cathedral of Orvieto where they remain today. Inspired by this miracle, Pope Urban IV commissioned our own patron saint, St. Thomas Aguinas, a Dominican friar, to compose the Mass and Office for the feast of Corpus Christi. St. Thomas Aguinas composed the hymns, Pange Lingua, Tantum Ergo, Panis Angelicus, and O Salutaris Hostia for this great Eucharistic feast of the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. To celebrate this great Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we will be doing a short procession around eight prayer banners in the church following the 10:15 a.m. Mass and will have some time for Eucharistic adoration after the completion of the procession until about Noon. We encourage our parishioners to participate in quiet with the Lord and give Him our undivided attention in the midst of a noisy, distracted, confused world.

Next week, we will have Mass in the Grass, not at 4:30 p.m. but 5:00 p.m. at the Amphitheatre on 602 N. G St., Indianola, Iowa. Please bring your own food, drink, and swim wear to change in for a little fun in the pool afterward. Fr. Peter Schavitz, C.S.S.R. will be our guest Mission speaker for the weekend. Please pray for our seminarians who will be ordained to the transitional diaconate next Friday June 11, 5:00 p.m. at St. Ambrose Cathedral. They are: Rodrigo Mayorga Landeros, of St. Bernard's, Osceola and Nicholas Smith, St. Augustine's Parish, Des Moines, who have completed their third year of theology at St. Paul Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota. 
