The theme was on the Mass, the highest and most important prayer we have as Catholic Christians! Your time, efforts, and creativity were most appreciated!

Please welcome Fr. Chuong Cao to Immaculate Conception, St. Marys this weekend! Fr. Cao, A Redemptorist priest, will be talking to us about their missionary efforts in foreign countries and bringing the Gospel or Good News of Jesus Christ to those they encounter!

Finally, a reflection upon this Gospel reading for this weekend.

A priest friend of mine who served at a parish close to downtown at one time would often get transients, some of whom lived under the bridges, stopping by and in need of assistance. It could have been very easy for him to pretend not to hear the doorbell, go hide, ignore, or shoe the people away. No, he took the narrow, more difficult road by opening the door, listening to them, and finding ways to assist them either through counsel or finances. He did this time and time again. He finds that this is not only personally satisfying, but more importantly, the call to be the kind compassionate shepherd.

Jesus exemplifies the true shepherd. When he sees the crowds hungry or in need, he gives them physical and spiritual nourishment of himself. He draws the people in and meets their greatest hunger-to know that they are loved and cared for by him. Sometimes, this involves kind, compassionate, and full attention given to another, sometimes, love involves tough love-boundaries made known and given to another, which we all need. This is the call for all shepherds, whether they be bishops, priests, deacons, moms, dads, teachers, business leaders, etc. We are invited into a Servant Leadership or a Servant Shepherd for those we are entrusted with. How is God inviting me into a care for the sheep I am entrusted with whether they be my children, my employees, my flock, etc.? Am I open to feeding their deepest hungers by pointing them to Jesus, the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for his sheep?




