PASTORS REPORT

Since Father Chris is on vacation, I was asked to write his column this week. Fortunately, this weekend's Gospel ties in with the theme of our recently completed Vacation Bible School, "The Mass Comes Alive".

Beginning last week and for the next few weeks, the Sunday readings present Jesus as the Bread of Life. If you were in church last week, you heard Father Chris talk about the miracle of the loaves and fish as a precursor to our Mass. Jesus had his followers sit on the ground as he took the bread, gave thanks, broke the bread and gave it to his followers. The miracle of Jesus transforming five loaves into feeding thousands and thousands of people and having more leftover was astonishing.

In the Mass, that miracle of Jesus taking bread, giving thanks, breaking it and giving it to us today as His body, blood, soul and divinity is even more powerful and astonishing in reality, although we don't see the dramatics.

Even in Jesus's time, people doubted Jesus was the Bread of Life. In next week's Gospel they question how could Jesus come from heaven. "Is he not the son of Mary and Joseph of Nazareth?" We also may wonder, "How can a tiny host be Jesus' flesh and blood that can transform our entire being?" We need to believe as children do with a pure and trusting heart.

Which leads to a story experienced at our Mission for Mini's Mass at a parishioner's home. Three of the young altar servers, without any instruction at the raising of the host, became the living bells, chanting, "ring, ring, ring the consecration -- giving praise with their whole being. They knew a miracle had occurred.

We are called to this sincere faith. Does the Eucharist change us? Do we act as if we have received the Bread of Life? May the Mass come alive in this way for all of us.




