PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Welcome to the MJM7 Band who are here at the Masses at St. Thomas Aquinas and will be inspiring us with Sacred Christmas Music this Sunday evening at 7p.m. in the worship space of the church. We are grateful for them being here with us this weekend.

This Wednesday is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. The doctrine was formally defined as dogma in the Constitution "Ineffabilis Deus" of December 8, 1854, Pius IX pronounced and defined that the Blessed Virgin Mary "in the first instant of her conception, by a singular privilege and grace granted by God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the Savior of the human race, was preserved exempt from all stain of original sin" (Denzinger).

This took place shortly after St. Bernardette had a vision of Our Blessed Mother who stated, 'I am the Immaculate Conception.'

We will be offering three masses for the Feast Day. We will have a 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Mass at St. Thomas Aquinas and a 7:00 p.m. Mass at Immaculate Conception, St. Mary's. I have asked Msgr. Frank Bognanno to assist me with the Masses for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

Last, some of you have been asking about the Christmas Schedule of Masses along with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I will have the Sacrament of Reconciliation one half hour before all weekday Masses. In addition, on Saturdays during Advent, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be from 3 p.m. until 4:15 p.m. On Sunday, I will have the Sacrament of Reconciliation at 7:30 a.m. at Immaculate Conception, St. Marys.




