PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We celebrate the Visitation of Marv with Elizabeth in this Gospel reading, the Second Joyful Mystery of the Rosary. Mary, a young teenage girl, is traveling some ninety miles from her home from Nazareth to the Village of Ain Karim by foot, which would have taken several days and supposedly alone yet having the Holy Spirit accompany her on this dangerous journey. These cousins share the Good News, one being very young, Mary, and the other Elizabeth, being quite old, past the childbearing age. St. John the Baptist, lept in the womb for joy, thus being cleansed of original sin in Elizabeth's womb. It is a time of joyful expectations while they await the births of the Precursor to the Messiah and the Savior, the Messiah, Jesus himself. The pregnancy of Mary would be without the labor pains as she was free of original sin and the birth would be like a light going through glass, according to the Church Fathers, particularly St. Augustine. Unlike Mary, Elizabeth would undergo the typical labor pains.

This is also a time of joyful expectation for us as we await the Savior in our midst. How might we prepare for his coming next Saturday? How might we prepare for the Second Coming, which could happen at any moment or time?

We still have time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. On Monday at Immaculate Conception, there will be confessions from 6-7 p.m. This Tuesday, Confessions will be from 5-6 at St. Thomas Aquinas, 1/2 hour before Masses on Wednesday and Thursday or by appointment, if none of these times work.

We will have NO Mass on Christmas Eve Morning, Friday December 24th nor on Saturday December 25th in the EVENING at 4:30 p.m. to give you all time to celebrate the Christmas holiday with your family. The usual Sunday Schedule will be in place. I would suggest that if you are one of the Saturday evening Mass attendees, please come to one of the three Masses on Sunday.

Due to the Christmas break, there will be NO Simpson Masses until Sunday January 23rd. If you happen to miss out on these times, I would suggest a 4:30 p.m. Sunday Mass at St. Theresa's, 5:00 p.m. Latin Mass at St. Anthony's, or one of the afternoon Spanish Masses at Christ the King.

Happy 4th Sunday of Advent and to those traveling, please be safe through the intercession of St. Christopher, St. Joseph Cupertino, and the Blessed Mother, and have a Merry, Blessed Christmas!


