# PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Last month, December 1st, the United States Supreme Court heard the case of Dobbs V. Jackson Women's Health Organization in Mississippi. The United States Supreme Court heard arguments with the constitutionality of a 2018 Mississippi Law that banned abortion procedures in the southern state after the first 15 weeks of pregnancy. The case will be decided sometime this year, most likely June 2022.

It could mean the end of Roe V. Wade, which began 49 years ago on this day. Since then, 4000 lives have been and are being taken daily due to abortion. Sixty million lives have been taken since Roe v. Wade was legalized this day 49 years ago.

This is a matter of human rights and consistency with science, as science states that life begins at conception. I would also argue in the words of former President Ronald Reagan, "I have noticed that those who are for abortion have already been born." Each of us has been given a precious life by God, why would we deny the right to life to someone else? The unborn are considered the poorest of the poor who have no voice nor any choice for that matter. As we remember the ruling of Roe v. Wade 49 years ago today, let us remember, pray and fast to end all abortion. In the eyes of God, all lives are sacred from the very moment of conception until death.
