PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

St. Thomas Aquinas has begun a Core Creation Committee. They have studied the encyclical, 'Laudato Si' (Praise be to You) from Pope Francis I. The document is on the care for creation and the environment. This initiative comes from St. Francis of Assisi who wrote the Canticle of the Sun praising all of God's creation. I encourage you to read their article on the next page of the bulletin and prayerfully consider joining the group.

This Wednesday, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. According to Jewish Law, the firstborn male child belonged to God, and the parents had to 'buy him back' on the 40th day after his birth, by offering a sacrifice of 'a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons (Luke 2:24)in the temple (thus the presentation of the child). On that same day, the mother would be ritually purified (thus the purification). The Blessed Mother, Mary and her spouse, Joseph kept this law, even though she remained a virgin after the birth of Christ. However, she would not have to go through ritual purification. Mary and Joseph would have presented Jesus to the prophet Simeon who had waited all of his life for the Messiah. He embraced the child and prayed the Canticle of Simeon (Nunc Dimitiis). "Now you may dismiss thy servant. O Lord, according to your word in peace; because my eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared before the face of all people; a light to the revelation of the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel." (Luke 2:29-32)


