PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

This Monday, February 14, our culture celebrates St. Valentine's Day. Although this saint was taken off of the General Roman Calendar in 1969 due to a lack of reliable information, he is still considered a saint. His name is St. Valentine. According to some accounts, St. Valentine was a priest and physician who gave his life for the Catholic Christian faith on February 14, 270 as a martyr under the Emperor Claudius II.

Another account named him as Bishop of Terni, Italy. According to a legend, St. Valentine signed a letter "from your Valentine" to his jailer's daughter, whom he befriended and healed her from her blindness. He was also noted as one who secretly married couples to spare the husbands from war, which defied the emperor's orders. He was tortured and beheaded.

In many ways, this day has taken on some pagan elements with Cupid and his arrow, yet, nevertheless, we see a model of one who gave his life in sacrificial love for God and neighbor following in the footsteps of Jesus, "Love one another as I have loved you." Also, there is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends. St. Valentine is the patron saint of beekeepers, epilepsy, the plague, travelers, fainting, engaged couples and happy marriages.(John 15). (sources: www.history.com Encyclopedia Britannica, Fr. 
