PASTORS REPORT

As Lent approaches -- this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday -- our thoughts turn to what can we do to change our lives to improve our relationship with God, our heavenly Father, who yearns for a closer relationship with us.

It's tough to change our lives, even for 40 days of Lent. As this Sunday's Gospel reading points out, it's a lot easier to suggest to others how they can make their life better. But pointing out the splinter in someone else's eye, even with good intentions, is not what God wants us to do. We need to work on getting the wooden beam out of our eye. That takes a good amount of self-examination.

So, what can we do to draw closer to God and reinforce the tight bond He wants with us? The Church gives us three extraordinary, sacrificial ways to do this in Lent: Pray, Fast and Give alms (alms are defined as money, food or goods given to the poor).

Looking at that another way: What can you do to love God and feel His love for you more deeply? What would you do for anyone whom you are in love with? Talk and listen to Him (pray); sacrifice something in your life for Him (fast), give to others to share His love and providence (almsgiving). Lent is all about building an intimate, loving relationship between you and God.

However, as the Gospel on Ash Wednesday tells us, don't "toot your own horn". Don't announce to everyone how much you are doing during Lent. In fact, God wants us to be humble.... Humble in our praying; humble in our fasting; humble in our giving to the poor. Only in our humility can we have the right relationship with God that God has planned for us all along. That's when great things can happen! And then, Easter will be the most beautiful, sensational, marvelous, life-enriching, love-affirming Holy Day you'll ever experience.

We're not going to tell you how to live your Lent (although see the bulletin for lots of ideas), because the wooden beam in our eyes is blocking our view of the splinter in your eye, and we intend on spending some time at the feet of Jesus planning our own life changes for Lent. Good luck to us all! Here's to making sacrifices in Lent that will lead to a glorious Easter.
