#### PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Welcome to the First Sunday of Lent! We begin with many things. I think first of all, we need to offer our prayers and fasting for the people in the Eastern European areas of the Ukraine and Russia. There have been global protests of this conflict, even in Russia, where many citizens have been arrested for voicing their displeasure at this conflict. The Ukrainians have been forced to flee out of their homelands into neighboring areas. The Church has tried to respond with humanitarian aid with the Ash Wednesday Collections. I would encourage you to pray the rosary for peace. The rosary has been a powerful spiritual weapon in stopping conflicts, particularly in the Battle of Lepanto in 1571, in which Pope Pius V encouraged the praying of the rosary in the European naval battle against the Ottoman Turks. The Holy Father attributed the victory of the European navy over the Turks through the intercession of our Blessed Mother Marv.

Second, we begin the kick-off for the Annual Diocesan Appeal this weekend. Immaculate Conception, St. Marys goal is \$22,583, while St. Thomas Aquinas, Indianola goal is \$66,596. If each household would prayerfully consider giving \$400, I believe we could meet our goal. Some of you may not be able to do this amount, some could give more. Any amount would be appreciated! The monies used will fund priest health insurance and pension fund, seminarian education, communications office which sends out the Catholic Mirror, the diocesan newspaper each month, education office which provides guidance to Catholic Schools and faith formation, the marriage office which offers resources for engaged couples and those seeking annulments, the finance office which offers resources for the financial stability of parishes, Bishop Joensen's salary, Hispanic and refugee ministry, etc. Thank you for your generous participation in the past and present! It has been and is most appreciated!

Third, I would invite you to pray for our baptized candidates who are seeking full communion in the Catholic Church. They will be welcomed by Bishop Joensen in the Call to Continuing Conversion at St. Francis of Assisi this Sunday afternoon at 4 p.m. They are: Stephanie Felice, Tom Lowe, Kristina Quijano, and Jill Zegers.

Last, but not least, I would like to congratulate Logan Grover who will be receiving his Eagle Scout this Sunday afternoon at 5:30 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose room!
