PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Happy Laetare Sunday! This day's theme is reflected by the prophet Isaiah, "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exalt and be satisfied at her consoling breast." (Isaiah 66:10-11)

Laetare in Latin means, 'rejoice'. On Laetare Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Church expresses hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten fasts and penances. To signify this joy, clergy wear Roman Rose (NO, NOT PINK), as the change in color indicates a glimpse of the joy that awaits us at Easter, just before we enter the somber time of Passiontide. We are more than half -way through Lent.

The joy of Easter being near us is symbolized with some liturgical possibilities. During Lent, the General Instruction of the Roman Missal forbids flowers adorning the altar. Yet, on Laetare Sunday (as well as Solemnities and feasts during the Lenten Season such as St. Joseph and the Annunciation), there is a temporary hiatus or break from the penitential observations. Rose colored roses can be used.

Also, at one time, the Sacrament of Marriage was forbidden during Lent, yet, this is a day in which the sacrament could be celebrated. While now, the Sacrament of Marriage is forbidden on Good Friday and Holy Saturday, Laetare Sunday is a fitting day for those wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage before Easter.

Like the Transfiguration was for the disciples before the Passion of their Savior and theirs as well, Laetare Sunday can be a great 'shot in the arm' as we approach the darkness and horror of Good Friday and Holy Saturday until the Easter Vigil celebration. This is a great day to savor, to cherish, to welcome as we await Easter. I would urge you to take time out this day to give thanks and praise to God and to be joyful in the Lord Jesus Christ, who died for our sins so that we might be saved!
