PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

It is hard to believe that we have ended the Lenten Season and have now entered the Easter Season with Easter lillies, with gold and white vestments, white banners, and new life displayed everywhere. The 'A' word (Alleluia) returns to the liturgy as well as the 'Gloria.' We are in a season of celebration over the next several weeks.

The Church has celebrated the Easter holiday for several centuries. The earliest recorded observance of an Easter celebration comes from the 2nd century, though the commemoration of Jesus' resurrection, more than likely, occurred earlier.

This year, we celebrate Easter on April 17, 2022 (the Sunday following the first full moon of the Spring Equinox set from the Council of Nicea 325 A.D. and later reaffirmed by Pope Gregory XIII in 1582). The English word Easter, parallels the word, Ostern (German). The Venerable Bede of the 8th century stated that Easter derived from Eostre or Eostrae, the Anglo-Saxon goddess of spring and fertility.

The Greek Orthodox celebrate Easter on different Sundays because they follow the Julian Calendar (from Julius Caesar 46 B.C.). They will celebrate Easter this year on April 24th, 2022. Like ours, their date varies from year to year. The date can range from early April to early May. (sources; Encyclopedia Brittanica and www.history.com)

Second, Divine Mercy Sunday is April 24, 2022. Divine Mercy Sunday is relatively new addition to the Roman Catholic liturgical calendar. This feast was extended to the entire Church by Pope John Paul II on April 30, 2000 as Jesus Christ revealed in a vision to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska His mercy to all of humanity. A plenary indulgence (the forgiveness of all temporal punishment resulting from sins that have been already confessed) is granted on Divine Mercy to all the faithful who go to Confession or the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receive Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and "in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of the Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to our Merciful Lord Jesus (ie. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you). A partial indulgence (the remission of some temporal punishment from sin) is granted to the faithful "who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation." Next Saturday, April 23rd, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available from 3-4:15 p.m. at Saint Thomas Aquinas and on Sunday April 24, from 7:30 a.m. to 7:55 a.m. at Immaculate Conception, St. Marys for Divine Mercy Sunday. If these times do not work out, I would invite you to attend Christ the King, 5711 S.W. 9th St. Des Moines, Iowa (my home parish) for the Sacrament of Reconciliation beginning at 2 p.m. on April 24th with Mass beginning at 3 p.m. Confessions will be available through the Mass as well.


Creation Care Corner

Sign-Up Sunday, April 23-24

After a couple of years of COVID isolation, we have some wonderful opportunities for your children to reconnect with God and establish that beautiful, loving relationship with Jesus. Please consider signing up on the weekend after Easter. We will have a table in the Gathering Space after each Mass.

First, Vacation Bible School, June 20-24 from 9 am – 2 pm. each day. We have the incredible honor of having the School Sisters of Christ the King from Lincoln, Nebraska lead our summer Vacation Bible School for children who have completed grades 1-8. We will also offer a pre-school/kindergarten program at the same time. Cost is \$5 per child.

The program came highly recommended and we are blessed they could fit us into their schedule. We really encourage Middle Schoolers to attend. And we would love some help from high schoolers. This is a terrific opportunity to experience the joy, humility and faith of nuns/sisters.

Second, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program for ages 3-6 and 6-9. This will be begin next fall during the school year. We will have sessions on Sunday morning from 9-10 am and on Wednesday during the regular Religious Education program.
