PASTORS REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

We celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity, Three Persons in One God, The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated in Western churches on the Sunday following Pentecost, a feast celebrated since the 10th century. From the 10th century, this feast gradually spread in Northern Europe and in 1334, Pope John XXII approved it for the entire church. The Anglican and Lutheran traditions date the Sundays that follow this feast, "after Trinity" while the Roman Liturgy dates these Sundays "after Pentecost." In the Eastern Orthodox tradition, the first day of the three-day Pentecost feast is known as Trinity Sunday.

There have been many who tried to present comparisons or analogies in regards to the explanation of the Trinity. One such analogy is three states of water-solid ice, liquid water, and steam. Unfortunately, this falls into the category of modalism, a heresy or false teaching of the church. What is modalism, we might ask? It is a singular God who has revealed Himself in three modes or forms. To be safe, I would stick with St. Patrick and the shamrock-one stem, three petals, which according to the worldly sense is not lucky, but nevertheless, a great expression of the love and communion between the three persons in One God.

That is what I would like to focus on for this weekend. The community of God consists of the perfect love of all three persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, One God, who spreads that love to all of us in a perfect way. We are called to do our best to reciprocate that love back to them in prayer and in deed. Let us pray that we may do that.
