

WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION: Cool Efficiently.

Making smart decisions about air conditioning can have a big effect on your utility bills, comfort, and air pollution.

- A dirty air filter slows down air flow and wastes energy. At a minimum, change the filter every three months in peak seasons.
- Close curtains or shades during the day on south and west facing windows for a 3-5% savings.

- If AC equipment is old and needs updating, consider replacing it with an Energy Star system for additional annual savings.
