Here are the hours needed. It would be great to have these hours filled before Lent begins.



St. Thomas Aguinas will be hosting the **Eucharistic Miracles of the World Exhibit** from January 31st through February 14th thanks to Iowa Catholic Radio. The Vatican approved International Exhibit was designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis. Carlo, an artist, cartoonist and avid computer enthusiast created the art for the panels before his death from leukemia at age 15. The banners will be displayed throughout the building to increase awareness of the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist and promote Eucharistic Adoration.

What is a Eucharistic Miracle?

Eucharistic miracles consist of unexplainable phenomena occurring after transubstantiation, such as a host visibly transforming into human tissue, a host surviving fire, a host bleeding or the Eucharist alone providing sustenance to a human being for a prolonged period of time.

In order to be considered a Eucharistic miracle, the event is investigated by a special task force before deciding it is worthy of belief. Secular sources are often used to investigate and confirm the miracle. Belief is approved miracles is not mandated by the Catholic Church by can reassure believers of God's presence in our world.

THIS WEEK'S STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:

Water heaters are the 2nd highest source of energy usage in the home. Save money and significantly reduce carbon emissions two ways: 1) wrap it in an insulating blanket - costing only about \$25 at your local home center, 2) turn down the thermostat from 140° (the standard factory setting) to 120°. Also, if it's time to replace the unit, consider a tankless water heater. Tankless units heat water only when needed and can achieve greater efficiency than standard tank-type water heaters. When replacing your water heater, make sure it's Energy Star rated. For more info on energy efficient water heating go to www.energy.gov/energysaver/water-heating/
