Father Adam's Five for March 31-April 6:

- 1. Holy Week Schedule: Holy Thursday 7 p.m. Good Friday 7 p.m. Holy Saturday (Easter Vigil) 8 p.m. Easter Sunday 8 a.m., 10:15 a.m., Noon. At the Noon Mass we will not use incense, and we are expecting a lighter crowd, so if you want to social distance or have repertory issues we'd recommend the Noon Mass.
- **2.** Thanks to all our parish groups who have submitted FY24's budget. Now that we have the numbers in, we are beginning to look at expanding our staff hours around the start of the Fiscal year (July 1st). We are looking at expanding areas such as youth ministry, music ministry, and custodial services.
