# Father Adam's Five for February 16 — February 22

- 1. Stations of the Cross will be Fridays at 7 during Lent.
- 2. Sundays during lent I will continue my homily series on Blessings. For the most part, I will preach at 4:30 p.m. Saturday, 8:00 a.m. Sunday, and 5 p.m. Sunday (Simpson Mass). Msgr. Bognano will celebrate and preach the 10:15 Mass.
- 3. Our FOCUS retreat for college students is coming up! We have students from at least 3 campuses attending- lowa State, U.N.I., and Simpson. Sign up soon to guarantee a spot- https://tinyurl.com/STA-SIB. Simpson students- your college is now covering the cost of the retreat. Please ask one of the members of the Catholic Student Organization for the code.
- 4. We are about to launch the Annual Diocesan Appeal. We did really well with last year's appeal; thanks to everyone who gave 1% of the total ADA or who setup recurring monthly gifts of \$15 or more through the Diocesan portal. When you give through the Diocesan portal, the Diocese covers the cost of the donation and we get full credit! Just be sure to select St. Thomas Aguinas. Our goal this year is \$76,413. I'm asking every family to set up a recurring monthly donation of \$15 or more to meet our A.D.A. goal. Once 85% of our families give \$15/mo or more, we will meet our ADA goal every year for the foreseeable future. As we work to get every family to the \$15/mo goal, I'm looking for 30 families to cover 1% or more of the ADA. I will be one of those families donating \$765 or more, so we need 29 more people to join me in taking care of the first 30% of the ADA while we work to get everyone giving \$15/mo.

FASTING/ABSTINENCE GUIDELINES:
Fasting (ages 18-59) on Ash Wednesday and
Good Friday means 1 full meal, two smaller
meals not totaling a full meal.

Abstinence (Ages 14+) means not eating meat on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of Lent.
