
- 1) Thank you to everyone who has contributed to the Annual Diocesan Appeal; with the holidays we still don't have updated numbers (and won't until next week!)

Creation Care Corner

Keep your home dry to prevent mold and mildew from proliferating. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recommends keeping an indoor humidity level of 30 to 60 percent. You can do this by opening windows to exchange air inside your house. Remember that stagnant air retains all the moisture from your activities, so you should allow proper air movement by creating a draft inside at least once a day.
