Father Adam's Five for September 26—October 2

- 1) I will be gone to a priest workshop September 29-October 3. Please say a prayer for all the priests as we continue our formation.
- 2) Thanks to everyone who has gone through the EMHC training and commissioning. We had 22 people complete the training, with many more in the process. Stay tuned for more training opportunities.
- 3) There will be a Eucharistic Procession at Simpson on October 6, starting at 3:45 at Smith Chapel. We're looking to start ChristLife part 1: Discovering Christ at the end of October for Simpson students. Please keep us in prayer!
- 4) We recently ended the fiscal year (June 30). Finance Council and I are preparing a detailed end-of-the-fiscal-year letter, but I'd like to provide a briefer update for you all now. Thank you for your generosity!
- 2024 ADA: We've made our \$76,413 goal, and any gifts we receive now come back to the parish.
- 2022-2025 Ignite! Campaign: People have paid \$255,416.61 out of our \$355,000 goal. We still have about another year for people to fulfill their pledges. The Diocese should be sending reminder letters.
- Current amount in Building Fund (Including Reserve): \$370,034.57
- Current amount in our Operating Fund: \$64,659.61
- Current amount in STAT Mission Trip Fund (After 2024 Milwaukee Expenses): \$21,365. Mission Trip 2022 cost \$21,844.38, 2023 cost \$17,775.09, and 2024 cost \$14,105.72.




