Father Adam's Five for November 13

"Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say,

'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.'"- Lk. 14: 28-30.

- 1) We are nearing completion of the initial rebuilding of our EMHC program- we have over 60 people active in the EMHC ministry, and 20+ yet to be commissioned. We still need about 10 more people to go through. https://tinyurl.com/STA-EMHC There are multiple trainings in this coming week, and there will be commissioning the weekend of the 16/17. We are on track to bring back the precious blood the first weekend of Advent (hopefully at every Mass).
- 2) Recently the United States Bishops revamped the process for becoming Catholic. We are currently working on what that means for our parish- but starting December 1, the new guidelines take effect. We are calculating and planning the best way to build a program going forward. - 3) Are you interested in helping us build/expand our C.G.S. program in the coming year? We need people willing to assist in the atrium, and to go through a Level 1 training. We are looking for Levels 2 and 3 trained catechists who are willing to help us build our program. We are working toward starting a Level 3 atrium, but we need more people willing to help with Level 1 and 2 before we can build Level 3.
- 4) We've been laying the foundation to build up/expand our music ministry. Our most pressing need is a music director. Would you be willing to take a one-question survey? https://tinyurl.com/STA-MUSIC
- 5) We've been expanding our use of technology. Parent Pages from CGS USA Words of Thanksgiving from the Holy Bible



This month we hear and give voice to the following words: "thanksgiving", "blessing", and "gratitude". We pause within our day, and in our prayer, to reflect upon how God has blessed us, and the lives of our children.

We find words of thanksgiving woven throughout the Holy Bible. It is good to remind our children as we gather at the family prayer table or when we pray before or after a meal, that we hear beautiful words in the Bible about our relationship with God.

This month we invite you to simply choose one of the scripture passages below and share it as a family. Perhaps this will become part of your prayer ritual for the month of November.

- * Light a candle.
- * Slowly and solemnly read the words from the Bible.
- * Allow for a moment of silence.
- * Ask the children, "What did you hear?"


