Creation Care Corner

For the next 4 Sundays of Advent, the Creation Care Team will suggest some tips to maximize holiday festivities while minimizing environmental impact.

- Gifts and Wrap Give a waste-free nature-loving gift like something we gave out to avoid plastic or ask for "presence" instead of "presents." Try wrapping gifts in cloth gifts, i.e. use a dish towel to wrap a kitchen item. If using paper, consider paper that will decompose, avoiding foil wrapping paper. Perhaps give a gift that needs no wrapping, such as free babysitting, tickets to a show or a hand-made gift. For kids' gifts, think of activities that you can do together instead of toys or more "stuff" they don't need.
- Cards Send an e-card to save paper and postage. Personalize them by adding pictures, music, graphics and/or video messages. If you love writing letters or notes in cards, try making them yourself with paper made from 100 percent recycled paper.
- Remember to make your holidays about family friends, food and fun not stuff!


