We all know plastics are bad for the environment and for our own bodies. If you'd like to reduce your personal consumption of plastics, here are some suggestions:

- 1. The first and foremost question to ask ourselves is: Do I really need this product?" Be aware of personal WANTS versus NEEDS. Stop buying things you don't really need!
- 2. Buy fruit and vegetables not packaged in plastic. Buy from farmers' market's when possible and of course, take your own bags.
- 3. Aim to purchase things in glass jars and bottles instead of plastic containers -i.e., drinks, jams, spreads, etc.
- 4. Think about buying bars of soap/shampoo instead of plastic pump bottles.
- 5. Don't buy bottled water. Get a reusable water bottle.
- 6. Say no to single-use plastics, such as drinking straws, knives and forks, and plastic-lined drink cups.
- 7. Use loose tea leaves most tea bags are sealed with plastic.
- 8. REFUSE Styrofoam food and drink containers. Urge your local restaurants to ban them.




