Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

"Waiting to begin religious education until the child is six or older (as has been customary in the Church in recent years) means that the focus will naturally tend to be on behavior, on what one is supposed to do or not do in one's relationship with God... the knowledge that is acquired by the older child tends to be on a more abstracted level, and thus, can be somewhat superficial rather than the deep knowing that is characteristic of the younger child." Religious Potential of the Child 6-12 Years Old, Sophia Cavalletti.

Sophia is one of the founders of Catechesis of The Good Shepherd. She was a Catholic laywoman and theologian who received a doctorate in Hebrew and Comparative Semitic Languages and was a biblical scholar. The methodology was approved by the Diocese of Des Moines more than 10 years ago and has 13 active programs in the Diocese. We offer sessions for children aged 18 months through third grade.

Creation Care

With our planet heating up, we all know it is important to conserve water. In the next few weeks, we'll give some tips as to how to do that.



In the Bathroom:

- Shorten showers: Even a few minutes shaved off your shower time can save significant water.
- Install low-flow showerheads and faucet aerators: These devices reduce water flow without sacrificing water pressure.
- Turn off the tap: Don't let water run while brushing your teeth, shaving, or soaping up.
- Check for leaks: Regularly inspect faucets, showerheads, and toilets for leaks, and fix them promptly.
- Consider a low-flow or dual-flush toilet: These toilets use less water per flush.






