St. Kateri Tekakwitha, feast day July 14

St. Kateri was born around 1656 in a Mohawk village in New York. She contracted smallpox around age four and it left her face badly scarred and discolored, as well as damaging her eyesight. Her given name, Tekakwitha, meant "she who bumps into things". She spent much time with the Jesuit missionaries and was baptized with the Christian name "Catherine", or Kateri, as pronounced by the Mohawk. Her Christianity as well as her refusal to marry was scandalous to her Mohawk relatives, forcing her to flee her family and village. She died at 24, her last words being "Jesus, Mary, I love you." Minutes after her death, her face was transformed- no longer scarred but radiant, signifying she was at home in heaven.



Ways to save water in the kitchen:

- Run full loads in the dishwasher and washing machines: Avoid partial loads to maximize water efficiency.
- Scrape dishes instead of pre rinsing: This simple step can save a surprising amount of water.
- Use the microwave or refrigerator to defrost food: Avoid using running water to defrost items.
- Store drinking water in the refrigerator: Instead of running the faucet to get cold water.






