Creation Care



It looks like we might be having some fall weather and with that the leaves will be turning and coming down. What to do with all those leaves????? The following is an excerpt from last Sunday's Des Moines Register taken from an articles from the Univ. of Wisconsin-Madison's horticulture department.:

- · Since leaves have nutrients that are good for the soil, if you have just a few leaves, such as 20% of the lawn, you can just ignore them. They will break down on their own.
- If you have a moderate coverage (up to 50%), you can run your lawn mower over them to chop them up where they will decompose over time and provide nutrients for your lawn.
- If you have a thick layer of leaves, rake or remove at least half of them.
- If you do rake, take them to the brush dump. Do not throw them in the trash.
- Avoid gas-powered lawn mowers and leaf blowers, since they are big producers of air pollution.


In honor of the Feast of the Rosary on October 7, the Knights of Columbus will be passing out rosaries after all the masses on October 4-5.




