- 2) We are still needing a few more households to have their photos taken for the directory- we had 250 signup, but a few have cancelled, and now we are short by 5 families.




Three dollars from each meal will be used to support: Helping Hand, Heal House, Hope Foundation and the Indianola Ministerial Association


