Because of your generosity, it is safe to say we are emerging from the financial situation of 2 years ago, when our Operating Fund had just over one month's worth of a reserve and our expenses exceeded our tithing revenue by a wide margin (see my December 2023 letter). Initial estimates show significant growth in our 2025 Operating Fund compared to this time last year. I'll provide a more detailed update mid to late January after our bookkeeping team has a chance to process end of year gifts. Thank you for making what we do here possible!



All male parishioners age 18 and up are always welcome to attend our meetings




Gathering Table


